<u>Music</u> – There are many tradition nursery rhymes with a London theme. During our topic lessons, we will be learning and reciting many of these nursery rhymes.

<u>PSHE</u> – We will be exploring our feelings and friendships throughout the term in class assemblies and circle time.



<u>Geography</u> – We will be looking closely at UK maps to identify counties and capital cities. We will also be exploring maps of London and identifying different famous landmarks.

<u>Term 1</u> Bright Lights, Big City

<u>Design Technology</u> –We will be researching, designing and making famous London attractions using suitable materials. We will also be building houses using cardboard boxes, similar to those built during The Great Fire of London. We will be exploring why the houses burnt down so quickly during the fire.



<u>Computing</u> – During the topic, we will be using the internet to research the London Zoo and finding out about different animals that live there. <u>Literacy</u> – Our class text this term is the traditional tale of 'Little Red Riding Hood'. We will be focusing on sentence formation, punctuation and further developing speaking and listening skills. We will also continue to teach phonics and recapping Phase 2 and Phase 3 sounds daily.

<u>Maths</u> – Throughout the term, we will be looking at place value (0-10) and finding different ways to sort objects to develop our reasoning skills. Towards the end of the term, we will also begin to look at addition, which will continue in Term 2. **Curriculum Overview**
