



**Geography** - Geography is the main subject we will be focusing on in this topic. The children will be learning about landmarks, human & physical features in both our local area and London, cities, countries in the UK, maps (including giving directions on a map), use of Google Earth to explore places far away and looking at aerial photographs.

**Term 3 & 4**  
**Bright Lights, Big City**

**Art** - The children will learn about an artist called *Stephen Wiltshire*. They will then have the opportunity to draw a London landmark using similar methods as the artist.

**Design Technology** - The children will be constructing tall buildings to make a city landscape using cardboard boxes and other large-scale materials. The children will also have the opportunity to construct London landmarks using construction kits.

**History** - In Term 1, the children briefly learnt about *The Great Fire of London*. The children will be discussing this important historical moment in more detail and looking at what, why, when and where it happened.

**Literacy** – This term we will continue to focus on sentence formation, use of punctuation and use of different word classes (adjectives, verbs and nouns). We will also further develop the children's speaking and listening skills. There will be daily phonics lessons; focussing on the next phase, whilst continuing to recap Phase 2 and Phase 3 sounds.

## **Curriculum Overview**

### **Term 3**

**Maths** – This term our focus is on subtraction within 10, 2D & 3D shapes and beginning to explore place value within numbers to 20.

The children will also be practising to recall their number bonds to 10 and counting forwards and backwards within 20.

**Science** – Seasonal Changes.  
We will be working scientifically during our teacher directed sessions and developing our scientific vocabulary.
