Applications for transfer to primary school for Reception Year in September 2025 will open on Tuesday 5th November 2024 and close on Wednesday 15th January 2025

We will be holding Open Evenings with the Head Teacher on Thursday 14th November at 4pm and Monday 18th November at 6pm. This meeting will not include a school tour and is aimed at parents rather than children. You only need to attend one evening.

We will also be hosting open mornings to give you the opportunity to look around the school and see it in its daily operation. These sessions will be held on Wednesday 20th November and Monday 25th November with arrival for 9.15 am. We will also hold an additional open morning on Saturday 7th December at 10am. Please inform the school office should you wish to book a place on one of our tours so we can ensure we are aware of numbers moving around the school at any one time. During this visit, the Head Teacher will be available to answer any questions and you will meet children in Year 6, who will give their honest opinion of the school, whilst showing you around.
