Next week our Year 6 children will be completing their Key Stage 2 SATS tests. They have been working hard leading up to these assessments and we all wish them the best of luck. Then, not long after the half-term, our Year 4 children will have their Times-Tables assessment and Year 1 will have their Phonics check. Year 2 will have assessments in reading, maths and grammar but these are not statutory tests anymore, rather tests that help give school and parents an idea of how children are attaining and progressing at the end of Year 2. While we continue to support children in different ways to reach their full potential, and understand that more formal assessments are part of education, we continually make sure that the children understand that these are just assessments and not something to unduly worry about. We ask children to do their best but nothing more than that. Results from the tests will be shown in school reports at the end of the academic year. If you have any questions about assessments, please don't hesitate to speak to your child's class teacher.

Mars- Red

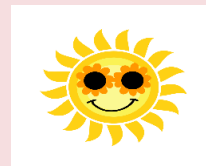
