## POLICE CADET ASSEMBLY

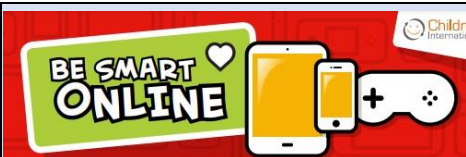

This week we are thinking about the rules and principles for keeping safe online, an essential part of helping children build confidence and independence in the digital

world. Just as we teach them how to stay safe in everyday situations, it’s important that children understand how to protect themselves when using the internet—whether they’re playing games, watching videos, or chatting with friends. Knowing simple steps, such as keeping personal information private, using secure passwords, and talking to a trusted adult if something doesn’t feel right, helps children make sensible choices online. By learning these principles early, children develop the skills they need to enjoy the internet safely and responsibly.
