Children are welcome to bring a small snack or small sweet treat to have during the interval (for example, a small bag of Haribo).

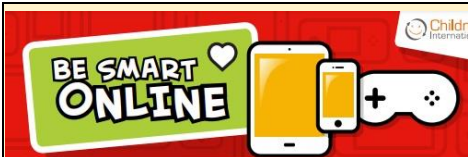

**TIPS FOR PARENTS AND CARERS: Online Safety – Let’s Talk About It!**

This week we are thinking about why social media, some computer games, and online gaming are age restricted. These age limits are in place to help protect children from

content or interactions that may be too mature, confusing, or unsafe for their age group. Explaining to children that age restrictions work much like film ratings—helping them access only what is suitable for their stage of development—can make the rules easier to understand. By following these guidelines, we can support children in enjoying technology safely, confidently, and in ways that are right for their age.
