Why is our wellbeing so important?

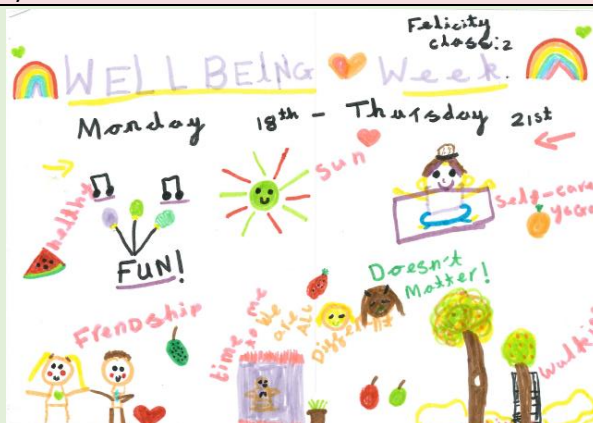
Things to talk about at home-
